Rules and Information for Education Day

Parking: Buses and cars should park in the south parking lot of Lawton Park. Buses will be met by a Historic Fort Wayne volunteer.

Name Tags: Everyone (students, teachers and chaperones) must wear NAME TAGS with their name and the name of their school.

Chaperones: Bring one chaperone for every 10 students.

Behavior: We expect students to be on their best behavior. If any should become boisterous and unruly we will ask that they leave.

Displays: Students are NOT to handle the displays of the participants unless invited to do so. Most items are owned by private collectors and are quite valuable. Students are not to enter any unmanned booths or rooms.

Lunches: Each student should bring a lunch with them. We recommend eating in Lawton Park.

Restrooms: There are modern restrooms available at the far south building on the grounds.

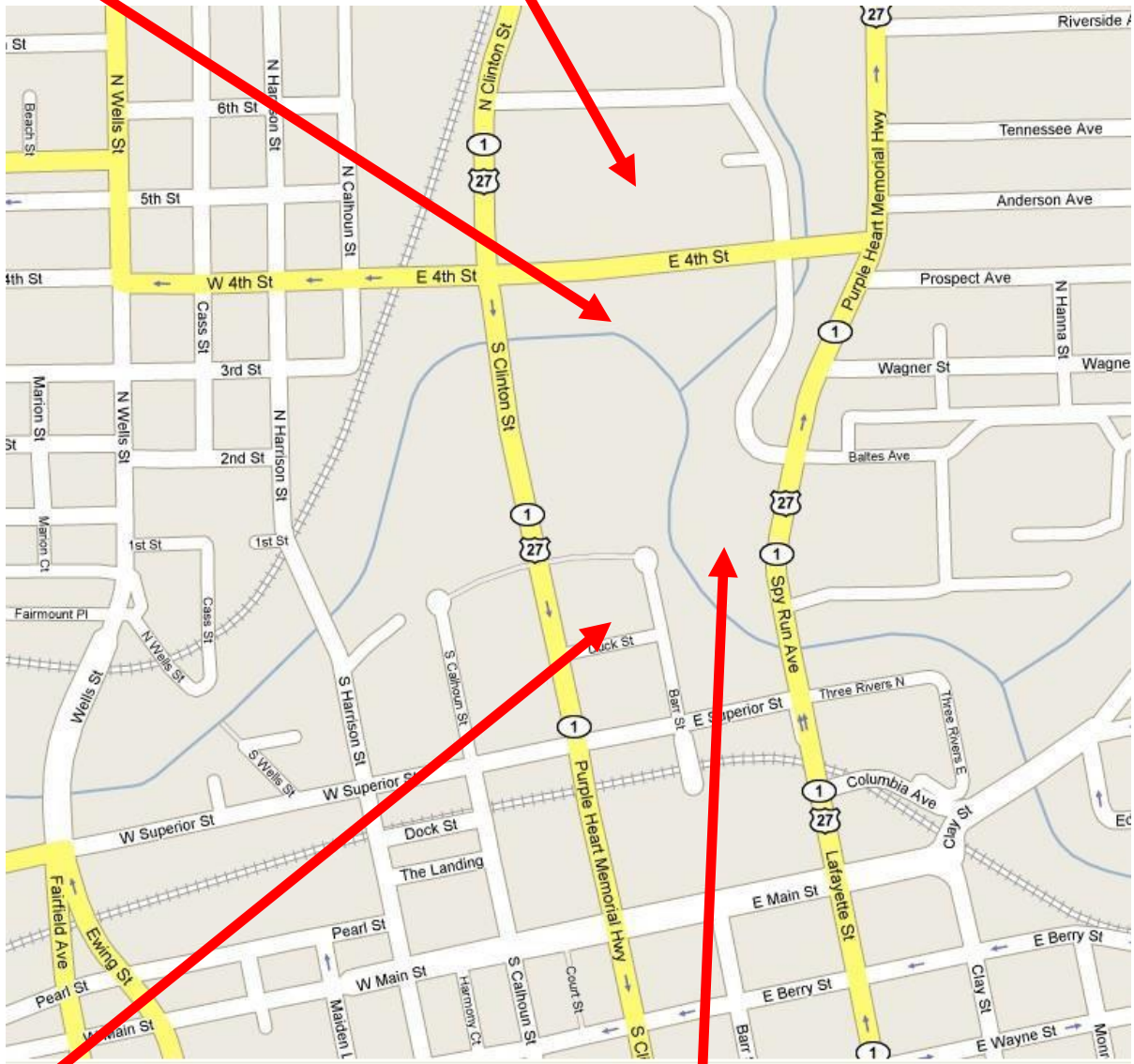
